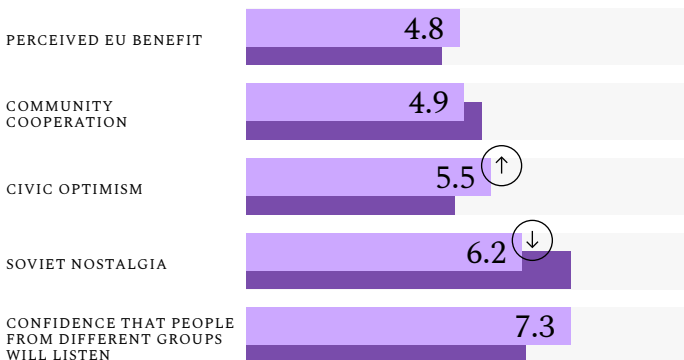

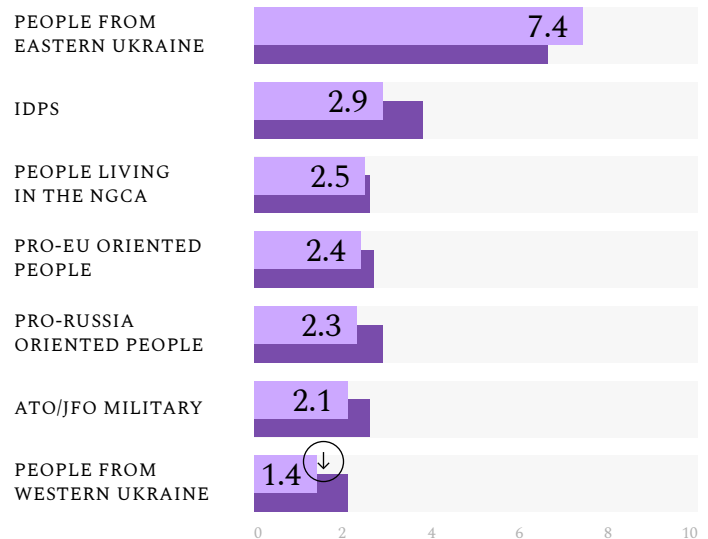

The frequency of direct personal contact with members of various groups in society



✓ People in Sloviansk feel heard by different socio-demographic and political groups but have less contact with these groups compared to other cities. Recommended interventions should create safe spaces for meaningful interaction and dialogue to strengthen community bonds and build convergences about the future direction of the community/country (e.g. community collectives and livelihood programmes).

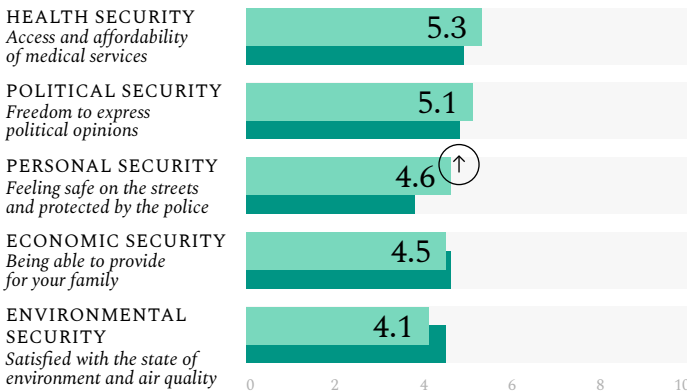
↑ Highest SCORE among 15 cities

↓ Lowest SCORE among 15 cities

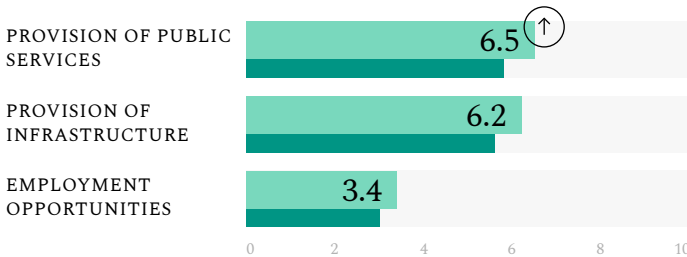
SATISFACTION WITH CITY LIFE

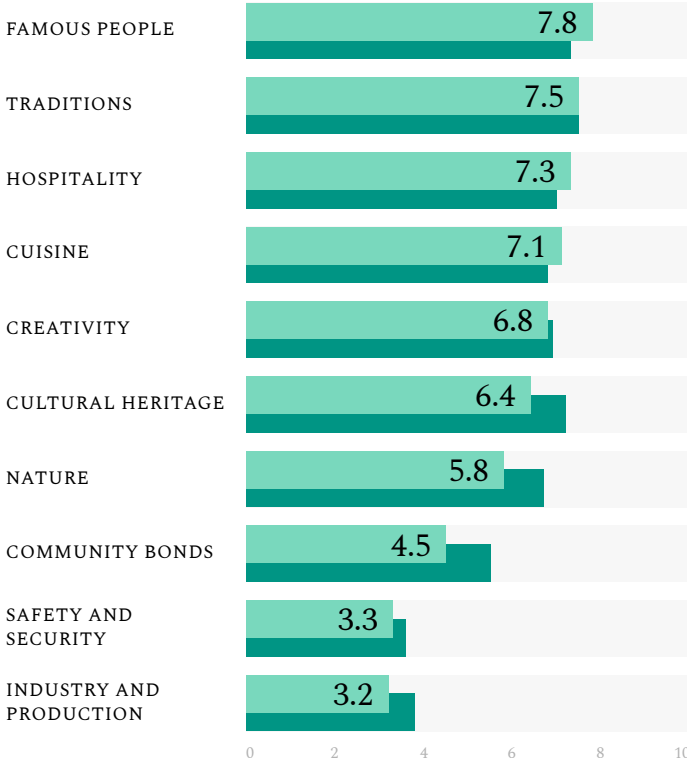

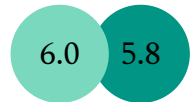
PRIDE IN YOUR LOCALITY

When you think about your locality, to what extent are you proud of the following?

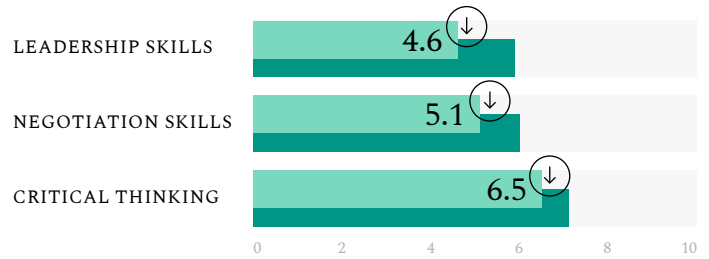


LOCALITY SATISFACTION

INDIVIDUAL SKILLS

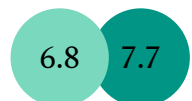

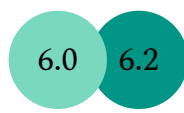

Citizens in Sloviansk feel less attached to their settlement, region, and country



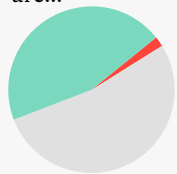
PRIDE IN LOCALITY (OVERALL)
